<b>Awarding Body:</b>	Faculty of Medicine on the recommendation of the selection committee which consists of the Chair of the Department of Medicine and Department of Surgery, a representative from the Divisions of General Surgery and a representative from the Division of Gastroenterology.
<b>Conditions:</b>	To be awarded to one or more graduate students in the Faculty of Medicine studying various forms of Inflammatory Bowel Disease, with emphasis on Crohn's Disease. Preference will be given to students enrolled in the Department of Medicine or Department of Surgery.
<b>Applications:</b>	Required.
<b>First Award:</b>	2006
<b>Successive Awards:</b>	Annually
<b>Authorized on Behalf of the Academic Board of the Governing Council:</b>	May 17, 2006

### NOTES:

1. The University will provide a dollar-for-dollar match of the gift of \$100,000 in the form of \$100,000 of capital to be added to the Fund from the Graduate Student Endowment Fund, and a permanent commitment of funding in the amount of one half of the annual payout on the combined Fund of \$200,000.
2. If no suitable candidate is found in any year, the income may be carried forward or added to the endowment.
3. The Faculty of Medicine will undertake to provide an annual report to the donors on the status of the fund and the name(s) of the recipient(s).
