

CLINICAL FELLOWSHIP IN IBD
(INFLAMMATORY BOWEL DISEASE)
At the **University of Toronto**

Applicants are invited to apply for a fully funded 1-year IBD fellowship. The program will provide advanced training in all clinical aspects of IBD, including medical management, endoscopy (including balloon dilatation and enteroscopy), surgery, pathology, and clinical studies and trials. Exposure to Pediatrics is optional. This program is for newly trained gastroenterologists who intend to open a clinical practice either in the community or in an academic setting.

The usual starting time of the fellowship is July 1st; however, this is negotiable. Candidates must have completed a recognized gastroenterology training program, and must be eligible for either a general or educational license in the province of Ontario. Interested candidates should send a covering letter, updated curriculum vitae, and names and addresses of 3 referees to:
